

How Synyega Achieved 100% Infrastructure Coverage and 95%+ Tagging Compliance With OpenOps

Executive Summary

Synyega, a FinOps consultancy delivering maturity assessments and training to enterprise clients, needed to practice what they preach. Managing their own multi-cloud environment across AWS and Azure while keeping a lean team required automation that could scale without constant maintenance.

After deploying OpenOps, Synyega transformed their cloud governance from semi-automated, distributed oversight to automated & centralized compliance. The platform now serves as their de facto compliance standard—policies are enacted in OpenOps first, with documentation following. Today, 100% of Synyega's infrastructure is reviewed by OpenOps, with tagging compliance exceeding 95% and untagged resources flagged within 24 hours.

Cloud Operations at Scale

As a consultancy focused on helping others optimize cloud operations, Synyega faced a unique challenge: demonstrating cloud governance and FinOps excellence while maintaining focus on rapid client delivery:

- **Resource Management Complexity**

With environments spanning AWS and Azure, manually tracking scheduling, tagging, and compliance across multiple subscriptions consumed time better spent on client work.

- **Tagging Discipline**

Maintaining consistent tagging across a growing infrastructure requires constant attention and care. Without automation, untagged resources would slip through and complicate cost allocation.

- **Environment Provisioning**

Creating standardized sandbox environments for testing and development required manual setup, introducing inconsistency and delays.

- **Engineering Fatigue Prevention**

Synyega understood firsthand that sending engineers long lists of small optimizations (\$5-\$20 items) leads to fatigue and inaction. They needed to automate the "long tail" of recommendations.

Previous Approaches

Before OpenOps, Synyega relied on manual processes and native cloud tools for compliance monitoring. While functional, these approaches didn't scale:

- Manual tagging audits were time-consuming and reactive

- Environment provisioning required repeated manual configuration

- Scheduling rules varied across accounts without centralized governance

The OpenOps Solution

Synyega deployed OpenOps in their AWS environment, leveraging single sign-on integration to connect seamlessly with their Azure subscriptions. The implementation focused on three core capabilities that transformed their cloud operations:

Intelligent Resource Scheduling

OpenOps automated the scheduling of non-production resources across both clouds:

- **EC2 and Compute Scheduling**

Any resource not tagged "Always On" is automatically scheduled, running only when needed.

- **Boilerplate Customization**

Synyega started with OpenOps template workflows and customized them for their specific needs—getting 80% of the work done out of the box.

- **Self-Scheduling OpenOps**

In a testament to their optimization mindset, Synyega even schedules the OpenOps platform itself, spinning it up for scheduled runs and turning it off when idle.

Automated Tagging Compliance

The tagging workflow became the backbone of Synyega's governance model:

- **Overnight Detection**

Every night, OpenOps identifies any newly created resources missing required tags and routes them to the appropriate team.

- **Intelligent Routing**

Resources created by known team members are automatically tagged based on owner metadata. Others are flagged for manual review.

- **Value Validation**

Beyond checking for tag presence, Synyega validates that tag values are correct—ensuring resources are tagged with appropriate values for their actual owners.

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Standardized Sandbox Provisioning

OpenOps streamlined environment creation:

- **One-Click Provisioning**

Engineers request sandbox environments through OpenOps, receiving a standardized set of resources with appropriate guardrails.

- **Consistent Governance**

Every sandbox automatically inherits the organization's tagging and compliance policies.

- **Reduced Friction**

Developers get what they need quickly without compromising on governance standards.

- **Rapid Deployment**

OpenOps deployment was straightforward, with Synyega's AWS familiarity making the initial setup simple. Cross-cloud connectivity to Azure proved seamless, enabling unified governance from day one.

- **Policy-First Approach**

Synyega adopted a unique operational model: OpenOps workflows are enacted before formal documentation. The platform serves as the source of truth for compliance standards, with written policies following implementation. This approach ensures policies are immediately actionable rather than aspirational.

- **Advanced Capabilities in Development**

Building on their success, Synyega is developing advanced tagging validation that cross-references resource creators with tag values—flagging cases where someone from one team tags a resource as belonging to another team. This capability, enabled by OpenOps' customizable metadata Tables, represents a maturity level beyond typical tagging compliance.
